

PORT MACQUARIE SURF LIFE SAVING CLUB – SOCIAL MEDIA POLICY

Reminder that this is an official Port Macquarie SLSC web page and thus is bound by the club's acceptable use policy. To allow everyone to enjoy this group, please note the new acceptable use policy for this group, is set out below, effective from 1/8/2019.

- By definition, “Social Media” can include, but is not limited to Facebook, Twitter or Instagram.
- This group is limited to financial members of the Port Macquarie Surf Lifesaving club only. Any member of the group that is identified as not being a member of the club, or ceases to be a member shall be removed from the group.
- Members are reminded that posts for this group should relate to Surf Club events/activities. Please do not post requests for fundraising/donations or advertising/promotional material that does not relate to the Club or has not had prior approval from the PMSLSC executive.
- You must not use this group in any way that causes, or is likely to cause, the group or access to it to be interrupted, damaged or impaired in any way.
- You must ensure that any content you upload to the group (including photographs) is not obscene, threatening, harassing, bullying, discriminatory, hateful, pornographic, offensive, defamatory, sexist, racist or vilifies in any way and does not breach any law or regulation (including but not limited to SLSA photography policy, especially with regard to children and SLSA use of Social Media Policy) or any intellectual property rights of a third party or any right or duty owed to a third party. This means that if any of the content you upload is copyright protected, you must obtain the copyright owner’s **written permission** in order to use it. If photos or video includes a minor, **written consent** must be provided by a parent or Legal Guardian.
- In the event that you become aware of any content which breaches any of the above rules, please notify us immediately by emailing secretary@pmslsc.com.au
- You must not use the group to misrepresent your identity or any other person or affiliation with any person or organisation.
- You must not use the group to send junk or spam email.
- You must not use the group to conduct, display or forward details of any survey, contest, pyramid scheme or chain letter.
- You must respond to others opinions respectfully and professionally.
- You cannot upload information of a confidential nature especially in regards to surf life saving services or members.
- You cannot directly express a political affiliation on an official PMSLSC social media account.
- You must not to use or attempt to use the group for any unlawful, criminal or negligent purpose. This includes but is not limited to password cracking, social engineering (defrauding others into releasing their passwords), denial-of-service attacks, harmful and malicious destruction of data, injection of computer viruses and intentional invasion of privacy.
- Port Macquarie Surf Lifesaving Club reserves the right to remove any content or person from any page without notice at its sole discretion. Further, disciplinary action may be instigated against any offending member found in breach of the aforementioned policy.
